Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the workbench is placed on a stable, level surface to avoid the risk of it tipping over.
- Only adjust the height when stationary to avoid injury.
- When loading and unloading the drawer, observe the maximum load capacity (50 kg).
- The maximum surface load of 1250 kg must not be exceeded in order to avoid structural damage or injury.
- Before using the workbench for the first time, check it for cracks or damage that could impair safety.
- The workbench is designed for commercial use and must be used in accordance with local safety regulations.
- Do not use the workbench near heat sources or damp areas.
- Use suitable tools for assembling the workbench.
- Avoid sharp edges or corners to prevent injuries.
- Check the anti-slip studs regularly for wear.
- To avoid serious injury, ensure that the workbench is fully assembled before using it.
- Users should pay attention to the weight of the workbench and, if necessary, get support to move it safely.
- The workbench is not suitable for use as play equipment in order to avoid injury to children.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (e.g. gloves) during assembly and use.
- Keep the work surface free of obstacles and ensure that it is clean to avoid tripping accidents.
