Safety Instructions:

- Pay attention to the maximum surface load of 1250 kg.
- Avoid using the drawer if it is overloaded (maximum load capacity 50 kg).
- Ensure that the chassis is correctly unlocked before moving loads.
- Protect the workbench from moisture to preserve the surface.
- Avoid improper use of the castors to prevent injuries.
- Ensure safe use by trained personnel only.
- Only operate the running gear on a stable surface.
- Check the coupling mechanism for functionality before use.
- Keep children away from the appliance, risk of crushing and injury.
- Always use the eccentric lever to lower the chassis to avoid injury.
- Make sure that the workbench is placed on a stable surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not exceed the recommended load capacity with the chassis extended (maximum 450 kg).
- When moving the workbench, always use the trolley in the folded state.
- Open and close the drawer carefully to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the workbench is stable when unfolded.
- Only use the workbench on level surfaces.
- When assembling the workbench, ensure correct manufacture and safety instructions.
- Lock the castors securely when the workbench is moved.
- Wear safety goggles when working with tools.
- Use the workbench on a stable and level surface.
- Read the operating instructions carefully and follow them.
