Safety Instructions:

- Protective toe cap shoe complies with the EN ISO 20345 S3 standard.
- The plastic cap protects against impacts up to 200 J and crushing up to 1500 daN.
- Puncture-resistant sole protects against penetration injuries caused by sharp objects.
- Suitable for use in ESD areas, prevents electrostatic discharge.
- Soles must be checked regularly for puncture and slip resistance.
- Use only with suitable shoe size and for the intended purpose in order to avoid blisters and injuries.
- The manufacturer is liable for the safety of the product; please observe the instructions for use and care.
- Keep shoes clean and dry to ensure slip resistance and material durability.
- If there are signs of damage, such as cracks, stop using the shoe.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years due to choking hazard from small parts.
- Avoid unnecessary exposure, especially to flames or chemicals.
- Do not use in explosive or flammable environments.
- Anatomically moulded footbed for comfort, try the shoe on properly.
- Use in high-risk work areas only after risk assessment.
- Suitable for wet conditions, but still avoid contact with wet surfaces to prevent slipping.
- Check shoes regularly for wear and replace if necessary.
