Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation from sharp edges of metal parts. Avoid contact with sharp edges and moving parts of the workbench to prevent cuts.
- Risk of serious injury if the vice is handled incorrectly. Use the vice properly to avoid crushing injuries. Check that the vice is securely fastened before use.
- Risk of falling due to insufficient stability if the height of the frame feet is not adjusted correctly. The height adjustment of the frame feet should be carried out by qualified personnel in order to guarantee stability.
- Risk of slipping on smooth surfaces without suitable anti-slip measures.
- Ensure that the workbench is stable to prevent it from tipping over during use. The workbench should be placed on a firm, level surface. Make sure that it is standing on a stable and level surface.
- The workbench should only be loaded up to the maximum surface load of 1250 kg. Do not exceed the maximum load of 1250 kg.
- Make sure that small parts and tools are stored safely in the drawers to prevent injuries.
- Before use, ensure that all components are properly installed and secured.
- When using electrical appliances on the workbench, follow the manufacturer's safety instructions.
- Children should only work near the workbench under adult supervision. Set up out of reach of children to avoid injury.
