Safety Instructions:

- Risk of suffocation due to improper use, especially for small children - therefore keep smaller parts and tools out of reach.
- The product must be set up stably to prevent it from tipping over - make sure that the workbench is placed on a stable and level surface and that the anti-slip knobs are checked regularly.
- Use in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions to avoid injury - follow the relevant instructions during assembly and use.
- Maximum load capacity of the drawer is 100 kg - avoid overloading to prevent breakage and injury.
- The maximum surface load of the workbench is 1250 kg - do not exceed this to avoid structural damage.
- Danger due to improper use: overloading, pinching or crushing possible - keep fingers away.
- Minimise the risk of slipping and tipping - use anti-slip studs and place the workbench on stable surfaces.
- Suitable for stationary use only - do not use in damp environments to prevent rust or material damage.
- Observe safety precautions when working with heavy objects - e.g. wear suitable personal protective equipment.
- Do not use the workbench as a work platform, ladder or for increased loads.
- Ensure regular inspection for damage or wear, especially of the anti-slip studs.
- Avoid the use of chemical cleaning agents to protect the worktop surface.
- Ensure that the workbench is out of the reach of children and untrained persons.
