### Safety Instructions:

- Not suitable for use in damp, wet or oily conditions.
- If the toe cap is damaged, protection can no longer be guaranteed. Check the condition of the shoes regularly for wear or damage.
- Flammable materials must be avoided. The shoe is not suitable for areas at risk of fire.
- Not suitable for use in explosive or extreme environments with extreme temperatures or aggressive chemicals.
- Avoid contact with chemicals or sharp objects, as this could corrode the material or damage the plastic cap.
- Check the shoe size and fit before use and ensure that the insoles are inserted correctly to avoid injury.
- Risk of slipping on smooth surfaces, even with shoes with ESD properties.
- Ensure suitable slip resistance on slippery or dangerous surfaces.
- Risk of suffocation due to loose parts such as shoelaces. Make sure they are fastened securely.
