Safety Instructions:

- Keep the cabinet closed when not in use to minimise the risk of accidents.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the cabinet to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not open or close sliding doors with excessive force to prevent damage.
- Place the cabinet on a stable and level surface to ensure stability.
- Children should only use the cabinet under supervision to minimise injuries.
- Follow the assembly instructions for correct assembly of the cabinet.
- Sliding doors can move suddenly; be careful with improper handling.
- Recommended maximum load for steel shelves: 70 kg per level.
- The rotary push cylinder lock offers additional security; check and maintain regularly.
- Do not use the cabinet in wet conditions to avoid rust.
- At least two people are required for transport or assembly to avoid injuries.
- Ensure that sliding doors are correctly fitted to prevent fingers from being trapped.
- Check the cover plate for damage to avoid sharp edges.
- Only place the cabinet on stable walls to prevent it from tipping over.
- Safety instructions should be provided in understandable language.
- Avoid blocking the sliding doors to prevent the risk of crushing.
- Ensure proper adjustment of the sliding doors to minimise safety risks.
- Do not exceed the intended load capacity of the shelves to avoid damage.
- Keep the cupboard doors clean and free of obstacles.
- Use the cabinet in accordance with its intended use to avoid injury and damage.
- Take care when closing the sliding doors to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the cabinet is correctly locked to prevent unauthorised access.
- Keep small objects out of the reach of children to avoid the risk of choking.
- Pay attention to the sliding doors; improper use can cause injuries.
- Follow the installation instructions for safe installation.
