Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the table is mounted stably to prevent it from tipping over.
- Use the worktable in accordance with the intended functions.
- Ensure that the table height is set correctly to minimise ergonomic risks.
- Avoid exceeding the maximum load capacity to prevent structural instability.
- Check the tabletop regularly for damage to minimise safety risks.
- Keep the work area clean to avoid tripping hazards.
- Regularly inspect the connecting elements and the frame for stability and wear.
- Use only under supervision and in accordance with the instructions of trained personnel.
- Include safety information and instructions for use in plain language.
- Suitable for commercial use; not for home use.
- Protect the table top from moisture to prevent damage.
- To avoid the risk of injury, do not use the table as a ladder or platform.
- Observe the behaviour when adjusting the height to avoid crushing.
- Not suitable for children due to small parts and risk of injury.
- Observe suitable safety precautions for electrical versions to avoid electric shocks.
- Pay attention to the maximum load capacity and do not use any non-specified accessories.
- Keep the table away from chemical substances to prevent surface damage.
- Make sure that the table stands securely on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Before use, carry out the adjustment mechanisms and height adjustment properly to avoid injury.
- Ensure that the product has been designed and manufactured in accordance with the applicable safety standards.
- Regular checks for structural integrity and specific table top requirements are necessary.
- Use protective devices in accordance with the applicable regulations.
- Be careful with mechanical stress on the table top, take protective measures with sharp or heavy objects.
- Check the clamping screws regularly to ensure that they are securely tightened to guarantee stability.
- It should be used in accordance with regional safety regulations.
- The table is not designed for high mechanical or chemical requirements.
- The melamine or plastic worktop is not suitable for working with chemical substances.
- Observe the safety information on the product label.
- Choking hazard due to small parts, not suitable for children under 14 years.
- Regular inspection of the height adjustment mechanisms and connecting elements is necessary.
- Ensuring the stability of the design to minimise safety risks.
- Avoid excessive load on the table top, distribute heavy objects evenly.
