Safety Instructions:

- Adjust the table height correctly to minimise ergonomic and health risks.
- Ensure the stability of the table on a flat surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Adjust the height safely using the clamping screws in accordance with the instructions to avoid injury.
- Only use the table in suitable environments to avoid material damage and safety risks.
- The table is not suitable for children; use safely and prevent access.
- Ensure that all parts are correctly assembled and screws are tightened to prevent instability.
- When using moist materials, always check their suitability for the selected panel.
- Regularly check the table top and frame for damage or wear to minimise risk.
- Keep the work area clean to avoid tripping.
- Do not use aggressive chemicals to clean the table top to avoid damage.
- Wear personal protective equipment (e.g. gloves) during assembly and use to avoid injury.
- Distribute the load evenly to minimise the risk of tipping or structural damage.
- When used in commercial environments, follow safety guidelines to avoid accidents.
- Suitable measures must be taken to prevent damage when working under high mechanical stress.
- Keep sharp or hot objects away from the tabletop to avoid wear or damage.
- Ensure that the table top is dry and the surrounding area is free of moisture, unless otherwise specified.
- Before use, make sure that all clamping screws are tight to ensure stability.
