Safety Instructions:

- Use only for the intended purpose. Not suitable for flammable or hazardous substances.
- Protect from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Withstands vibrations, but cannot be dropped or hit.
- Take suitable precautions when handling to avoid injury.
- Observe the local regulations for disposal.
- Make sure that the waste bin is placed on a firm and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Keep the waste bin away from children to avoid injury.
- Make sure that the lid is closed after use to prevent odours and insects.
- Clean the waste bin regularly to ensure hygiene and cleanliness.
- To avoid injury, make sure that the front wall of the waste bin is securely closed.
- The waste bin can become unstable if the contents are heavy. Make sure that it is placed on a stable surface.
- Regularly check the fastening of the elasticated strap for secure closure of the front wall.
- The waste bin can tip over if used incorrectly. Always use it upright.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper insertion of bin liners or overfilled bins.
- Risk of injury from sharp edges or corners of the container.
- Risk of slipping when moving the container in wet conditions.
- Use of the pedal requires supervision to ensure that children are not in danger.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper handling of small parts during disposal.
- Risk of injury due to improper use of the pedal or the removable front panel.
- Ensure that the waste container is used in direct contact with food (ensure HACCP conformity).
- Possible hazards during transport, especially when lifting or moving due to the weight.
- Beware of crushing hazard when closing the lid.
- Do not load too heavily to avoid tipping over.
- Place securely on a stable surface.
- Keep away from fire and extreme temperatures.
- Regular cleaning recommended to ensure hygiene.
