Safety Instructions:

- When using drawer units, avoid the risk of injury from unintentional simultaneous opening of several drawers. Always use the individual drawer lock to minimise this risk.
- The maximum load per drawer is 35 kg. This limit must be strictly adhered to in order to avoid structural damage and injury.
- Ensure that the drawers are mounted at the correct height and on stable, level surfaces to avoid ergonomic problems and the risk of tipping.
- Drawers with uneven surfaces or uneven loading can affect stability and should be used with particular care.
- Before use, check that all screws and fastening elements are tight to avoid instability.
- Risk of injury from sharp edges: Handle the product with care during assembly and use.
- Drawer bases are not suitable for use in damp or wet environments; keep them away from water sources to avoid corrosion.
- The drawers are only suitable for use by adults or under adult supervision as they contain potential crushing hazards.
- Use the cylinder lock to store tools and small parts to prevent theft. Keep the key in a safe place.
- Keep tools and small parts out of the reach of children to minimise the risk of injury.
- Follow the installation instructions carefully to ensure the safety and functionality of the product.
