Safety Instructions:

- The drawers are equipped with an individual pull-out stop that prevents several drawers from opening at the same time to avoid the risk of crushing and injury.
- Maximum load of the drawers is 35 kg. Do not overload drawers to prevent damage or tipping over.
- Keep the drawers closed when not in use to avoid accidents.
- To avoid falls or injuries, do not use the drawers as a ladder, seat or to reach higher objects.
- Make sure that sharp or dangerous objects are stored safely to avoid injury.
- Keep the key for the cylinder lock in a safe place and use the keys supplied to prevent unauthorised access and theft.
- The drawer substructure must be stable, use only on a stable and level surface to avoid tipping over.
- For safe use, follow the instructions and safety information contained in the product.
- The product is not suitable for use by children under the age of 14, so always take special care or supervise children.
- Ensure that the product is correctly assembled before it is used to avoid stability risks.
- Only use the product under the intended work tables and observe the load limits to avoid stability problems.
- Use the drawers safely and responsibly to avoid damage to property.
- Keep the product away from naked flames and extreme temperatures.
- Take suitable safety measures for use with children.
- Check the cylinder lock and central locking system regularly.
