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Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that all moving parts, such as door contacts and locks, function properly to avoid injury and prevent failure.
- To prevent material deformation, do not use the clothes locker in areas with extreme temperature fluctuations.
- Keep the clothes locker clean and dry to prevent mould growth and damage to stored items. In addition, corrosion of the steel material due to moisture can be prevented.
- Avoid overloading the clothes locker or placing heavier weights than recommended to prevent instability and damage to doors or hinges.
- Ventilation slots must be kept clear to ensure proper ventilation.
- The rotary bolt lock or cylinder lock must be operated in accordance with the instructions in order to avoid damage or crushing. Also make sure that the key does not get stuck in the lock to prevent it from falling out.
- Ensure that the locker is placed on a stable surface and secure it to prevent it from tipping or tipping over, especially with heavy loads.
- The clothes locker is not suitable for use as a seat and should be placed out of the reach of children to minimise the risk of injury.
- Protect yourself from sharp edges and corners by regularly checking them for damage. In general, take care not to place any sharp or heavy objects on the locker that could fall down.
- The locker is not suitable for children under 36 months due to the risk of suffocation from small parts or risk of injury from improper use.
- Clean the interior regularly to avoid accidents caused by falling objects. Remove all packaging materials before use to avoid the risk of tripping.
