Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the desk is mounted stably and stands on a level surface to avoid the risk of tipping.
- Do not exceed the maximum load and height settings (650-850 mm) to prevent stability risks.
- Avoid contact with liquids, hot objects and sharp objects on the tabletop to prevent damage.
- Securely fasten cables and accessories to minimise tripping hazards.
- Assembly requires compliance with the instructions and should be carried out by trained personnel.
- Children should not use or play with the desk and its accessories unsupervised to avoid injury.
- Regularly check for loose screws or swaying parts to reduce safety risks.
- Use cable outlets properly to avoid tripping hazards.
- Make sure that there are no loose small parts to prevent children from choking.
- Do not use unsuitable cleaning agents or leave the table in damp areas to avoid damaging the material.
- Take care when adjusting the height to avoid crushing; should only be carried out by adults.
- Do not place any heavy objects over the recommended limits on the tabletop to prevent dangerous loads.
- Sharp edges are bevelled or rounded, but be careful when assembling.
- With electric height adjustment, ensure that no body parts are trapped.
- Keep out of the reach of children to prevent injury from improper use.
- The surface is sensitive, so do not use aggressive cleaning agents.
- The instructions for installation and use should be clear and written in the local language.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to small parts that can be swallowed.
- Manufacturers should update safety information as necessary to provide consumers with clear access to information about risks.
