

Product Safety Information

Perforated tool plate, for table widths from 1250 to 2000 mm, f. Universal/Profi series

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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Safety Instructions:

- The perforated tool plate can only be fitted in conjunction with a Universal and Profi series mounting portal.
- Assembly and use must be carried out in accordance with the enclosed instructions in order to avoid injury.
- Regular checks of the fastenings and stability are necessary to ensure safety.
- Sharp edges and corners must be avoided during handling to prevent injuries.
- When using in the vicinity of children, note that small parts pose a choking hazard.
- Not suitable for children under 3 years of age to avoid the risk of choking on small parts.
- Use protective equipment (gloves, safety goggles) to prevent injuries.
- Do not exceed the recommended table widths (1250 mm to 2000 mm) to ensure secure fastening.
- Before installation, all parts must be checked for correct and secure installation.
- Only personnel familiar with the fastening mechanisms should carry out the installation.
- During installation, all screws and fixings should be firmly tightened to prevent failure.
- The product should not be overloaded in order to minimise structural damage.
- Unsuitable for use in humid or corrosive environments.
- If the product is damaged, do not use it and contact the manufacturer.
- Ensure that the perforated mould mounting plate is securely mounted on the steel mounting portal provided.
- Pay attention to dangerous sharp edges, risk of injury and improper attachment during installation.
