Safety Instructions:

- Max. Load capacity: 450 kg to avoid structural damage or injury.
- The work table is equipped with electro-hydraulics. Take care when handling to avoid the risk of electric shock.
- Electro-hydraulics must be checked regularly for functionality and safety.
- Cables and power connections must not be damaged in order to avoid short circuits or electric shocks.
- Keep the working environment free of tripping hazards. The table must be placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- The table top is not suitable for work with high mechanical or chemical requirements.
- Children should be kept away from the worktable to avoid the risk of injury from moving parts.
- Avoid using the table in damp environments to minimise electrical risks.
- Before use, ensure that the table is correctly assembled and that all safety instructions are followed.
- Safety information and operating instructions must be read before use.
- Do not overload; do not exceed the maximum load of 450 kg.
- Regular inspections and maintenance of the electrical components are necessary to ensure proper functioning.
- Beware of the risk of crushing, especially when adjusting the height of the table.
- Before use, ensure that the product is placed in a stable position and connected correctly.
- The electro-hydraulic system may only be serviced by authorised personnel.
- The table should only be operated with the intended mains voltage (230 V).
- Power supplies must be disconnected from the mains when not in use to prevent unintentional activation or electrical hazards.
- Ensure even load distribution to prevent the table from tipping or falling over.
- Children and inexperienced users should not use the product independently.
- To avoid injury, follow the safety instructions for using the various functions of the table.
