Safety Instructions:

- Be aware of the risk of injury from sharp edges and corners, especially with sheet steel carcasses.
- Choking hazard due to small parts and parts that can be swallowed, caution with improper use.
- Risk of collision when opening the doors hinged on the right.
- Use of the security cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Regularly check the functionality of the safety cylinder lock and ensure that it is always closed.
- Ensure ventilation through perforated rosettes in the rear wall, avoid blockage to prevent mould formation.
- Do not allow children to access the cupboard unsupervised, use under adult supervision.
- The construction must be stable and the safe deposit box must be anchored to the floor to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not overload to ensure stability. Avoid heavy or bulky objects.
- Keep keys safe and out of the reach of unauthorised persons.
- The cabinet is not suitable for use by children under 3 years of age.
- Do not lift the cabinet alone to avoid injury from the weight.
- Do not use the cupboard as a climbing aid to avoid falls.
- Windows for ventilation must not prevent owners from reaching the interior.
- Take care when using keys and avoid damaging them.
- Keep the cabinet away from moisture and extreme heat to avoid material wear and potential hazards.
- Ensure that the cabinet is used in accordance with the instructions provided to avoid safety risks.
- Keep a minimum distance from walls and other furniture to ensure good air circulation.
