Safety Instructions:

- The drip tray is to be used with hazardous materials and is suitable for substances hazardous to water of GHS categories 1-4 and flammable liquids of GHS categories 1-3.
- Maximum load capacity of the drip tray is 1000 kg/m². Protection against overloading.
- Ensure that the drip tray is always used on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over or slipping.
- Keep the drip tray away from heat sources, naked flames and ignition sources to avoid the risk of fire.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (e.g. gloves, safety goggles) when handling hazardous substances.
- Avoid risk of suffocation from chemical substances; store products out of the reach of children.
- Carry out regular inspections of the drip tray for cracks, damage or signs of corrosion.
- Obtain and observe safety data sheets for the hazardous substances used to ensure safe use and disposal.
- Only use the product for its intended purpose in order to avoid hazards.
- Have a suitable extinguishing device ready near the filling station.
- Dispose of in accordance with the applicable local guidelines and regulations for hazardous waste.
