Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the screens are stable to prevent them from tipping over and causing injury.
- Avoid direct sunlight and contact with water to prevent colour fading and material damage.
- Clean the screens and fabric covers according to the recommended care instructions using suitable, non-abrasive cleaning agents.
- The screens are only suitable for indoor use and should not be used outdoors or in damp environments.
- To minimise the risk of fire, do not place the screens near heat sources or naked flames.
- Keep the area around the partition free of obstacles to avoid tripping hazards.
- Ensure that all connections and connectors are regularly checked for strength, especially if they are used regularly.
- All manufacturer's instructions must be followed exactly during assembly to ensure stability and safety.
- Children should be supervised in the vicinity of movable walls to prevent accidents and incorrect use.
- The partition walls should only be used for their intended function as a partition wall and privacy screen.
- Be aware of possible allergies or sensitivities to fabric-covered surfaces and use in well-ventilated rooms.
- Ensure that no parts of the screen are used as toys to minimise the risk of suffocation.
- Only use the recommended accessories and connection materials to ensure the stability and safety of the construction.
- Make sure that the partition wall is not used as a climbing frame or seat to avoid injuries.
- Do not set up the screen near sources of fire, as the fabric covers may be highly flammable.
- Make sure that the product is stable during use to prevent it from tipping over.
