Safety Instructions:

- Use only for the intended purpose.
- Small parts can choke, therefore keep away from children.
- When using the product, watch out for sharp edges and corners to prevent injury.
- The product is not suitable for outdoor use.
- Ensure that the cylinder lock is secured to prevent unauthorised access.
- Ensure that the clothes locker is stable and cannot tip over. Make sure that the locker is supported and cannot tip over.
- Keep keys or lock systems safe from children.
- When installing the locker, ensure that all parts are correctly attached. Read the assembly instructions carefully before use.
- Regularly inspect the locker for possible damage or wear. If the locker is damaged, contact the manufacturer immediately.
- Suitable for the safe and organised storage of clothing. The locker is only intended for storing clothing and equipment.
- Avoid contact with sharp edges or moving parts during use and assembly.
- If the product is installed or used incorrectly, this may result in injury or damage to property.
- Do not place any heavy objects on the locker. Take extra care when placing heavy objects to avoid overloading.
- Do not use aggressive cleaning agents when cleaning the spindle.
- Keep the cabinet away from direct sources of heat and moisture to prevent corrosion and damage.
- Ensure that all doors and locks function properly to ensure the security of the contents.
- Choking hazard due to small parts or improper handling.
- Risk of mechanical injury from sharp edges or moving parts.
- Information on safe use and installation required. When using the cylinder lock, ensure that the key does not remain in the lock.
- Make sure that the doors are not in the way when opening to avoid injuries. Conserve resources when closing the doors to avoid damage.
- Include clear instructions for safe transport and storage.
- Only use the intended lock types to ensure security.
- The ventilated shelves and slots must be kept free from contamination to ensure proper ventilation.
