Safety Instructions:

- Avoid pinching body parts when closing the doors.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of the bench seat; observe load limits of 150 kg.
- Ensure that coat hooks are securely fastened to prevent injuries.
- Regularly check the stability of the cupboard and other furniture to prevent it from toppling over.
- Follow the installation instructions and only use the product for its intended purpose.
- Choking hazard due to small parts - Do not place within the reach of children or infants under 36 months.
- There is a risk of falling due to unsafe use of the bench. Ensure that the structure is stable.
- Use rotary bolt locks with suitable padlocks (shackle thickness 5-7 mm) to ensure security.
- Ensure that the clothes locker is in a stable position to prevent it from tipping over.
- Do not use any liquids or hazardous materials inside the cabinet.
- Regularly check that doors are securely locked to prevent unintentional opening.
- Regular inspection for cracks or damage to the furniture.
- Take care not to overload the compartments.
- Only accessible to children under adult supervision or for vulnerable persons.
- The cabinet should stand on a stable, level surface.
- If the product is damaged, take it out of operation and follow the recall instructions if necessary.
- Cutting and crushing hazard due to moving parts.
- Mounting materials should be securely attached and any sharp edges should be avoided.
- Check for stability and correct functionality before use.
- Protect the barrier from water and excessive heat.
- Leave ventilation slits unblocked for sufficient air circulation.
- Keep the working area around the cabinet free of obstacles to minimise the risk of tripping.
