Safety Instructions:

- Do not use the product as a toy.
- Watch out for sharp edges and points.
- There is a risk of injury in the event of improper installation or use.
- Not suitable for children under 36 months; choking hazard due to small parts.
- Avoid overloading and observe the maximum load.
- Lock doors properly to prevent injuries.
- Regular inspection for damage and functionality recommended.
- Place the clothes locker in a stable and secure position to prevent it from tipping over.
- Use suitable padlocks (shackle thickness 5-7 mm) to secure the doors.
- Ensure that the ventilation slots are not blocked to ensure proper air circulation.
- Keep the clothes locker dry to prevent corrosion and damage.
- Strictly follow the manufacturer's instructions for safe installation.
- Do not use as a climbing frame for children.
- Do not use any chemical cleaning agents.
- Do not overload clothes rails and doors.
- Tools may be required for assembly.
- Use locks securely, do not let keys fall into the wrong hands.
- Sharp edges or corners can lead to injuries.
- Ensure that the wardrobe is inaccessible to children to avoid the risk of suffocation or strangulation.
- Place the product out of the reach of small children.
- Check the product regularly for stability and condition to avoid safety risks.
- The use of padlocks not intended for the product can lead to defects.
- Avoid heavy or sharp objects on the wardrobe.
- Check the ventilation slots regularly to prevent moisture build-up and mould.
- Pay attention to the weight of the product, use suitable transport and storage methods.
- Only use on dry clothing to avoid the risk of corrosion.
- If the product is damaged or malfunctions, stop using it immediately and consult a specialist.
- Ensure that the materials required for installation are suitable.
