Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the clothes locker is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Only use suitable padlocks with a shackle diameter of 5-7 mm for the security twist lock.
- Be careful when mounting or repositioning the spindle and avoid jerky movements to prevent injury.
- Check the clothes lockers regularly for damage and functionality in order to minimise the risk of injury and material fatigue.
- Ensure that all doors and connecting parts are securely fastened and functional to prevent tipping.
- Do not overload: Ensure even weight distribution and observe the maximum load capacity of the compartments and coat hooks.
- Only use the clothes locker for its intended purpose and do not store heavy objects on the doors.
- Observe safety measures to avoid injuries when handling the doors and small parts. Children should not have unsupervised access.
- Leave the ventilation slots free to ensure sufficient air circulation and prevent mould growth.
- Ensure that the locker is stable on a level surface and without shifting loads to avoid the risk of tipping.
- Keep the clothes locker dry to prevent corrosion.
- Provide additional safety information and instructions for proper installation and care to prevent improper use.
- If the product is damaged, discontinue use to avoid safety risks.
