Safety Instructions:

- Observe the maximum load to avoid structural damage and to prevent material failure or collapse.
- Ensure that the wardrobe/clothes locker is stable and on a level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Ensure that the cabinet is not positioned near sources of heat or water to prevent material damage.
- Carry out assembly and installation in accordance with the enclosed instructions in order to avoid safety risks.
- Only use suitable padlocks to secure the rotary bolt lock or cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Children should not have access to the cupboard to avoid accidents and the risk of choking on small parts.
- Sharp edges and corners can pose a risk of injury - take care when installing and handling.
- Make sure that all parts are correctly assembled to ensure stability and minimise risks.
- Avoid opening or closing doors with excessive force to prevent damage.
- If the clothes locker is classified as dangerous, stop using it immediately and contact the manufacturer.
- Always close the door completely to avoid injury and to prevent the hinges from colliding.
- During use, ensure that children do not climb in the cupboard to minimise the risk of accidents.
- Regular inspection of coat hooks, brackets and structural integrity to ensure safety.
- The clothes locker should not be used by children under the age of 3 to avoid injury.
