Safety Instructions:

- Make sure that the table is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- The electric height adjustment should only be operated by persons who are familiar with the function in order to avoid injury. Keep children and pets away from the mechanism.
- Make sure that there are no objects or people in the table's movement range when it is being electrically adjusted to avoid injuries caused by collisions.
- The anti-collision system should be active to prevent damage in the event of obstacles and to prevent injuries when raising or lowering the table. Make sure that the system is not blocked.
- The maximum load of the table is 100 kg dynamic and 150 kg static. Do not exceed these weights to avoid damage.
- Avoid using electrical components near water sources to prevent the risk of electric shock.
- Regular checks of the functionality of collision protection and electrical components are necessary to ensure safety.
- Assembly and installation must be carried out in accordance with the enclosed instructions to ensure safety and functionality.
- Cable management should ensure that there are no tripping hazards caused by loose cables to prevent accidents.
- Use the control panel with memory function in accordance with the instructions to avoid malfunctions or unintentional movements.
- The table must not be loaded with more than 100 kg dynamically or 150 kg statically. Only use the height adjustment with free space around it to avoid collisions.
- Avoid overloading the table top to prevent it from tipping over or structural damage.
- Children should not play near the height-adjustable table without supervision in order to minimise the risk of injury.
