Safety Instructions:

- For safe use of the folding carton, the recommended storage and assembly guidelines must be observed.
- The folding carton should not come into contact with chemical substances or sharp objects in order to avoid damage.
- The material of the folding carton should be securely fastened with adhesive tape to prevent it from slipping during transport.
- Not suitable for contact with food unless specifically stated.
- If stored improperly, moisture can impair the strength of the cardboard.
- Take care when transporting heavily loaded cartons; observe safety measures for lifting.
- Do not store the boxes near open flames, excessive heat or other sources of heat to avoid the risk of fire.
- Please dispose of packaging materials in an environmentally friendly manner.
- Cartons made of 1 and 2-wall kraft paper should not be used in direct contact with food unless they are expressly authorised for this purpose.
- Kraft paper is moisture-resistant, but not waterproof. The boxes should therefore not be used for storing or transporting liquids.
- Ensure that the boxes are stored on a stable, level surface to prevent them from tipping over or collapsing.
- Avoid excessive pressure or additional weight on the cartons to ensure their structural integrity.
- The boxes should be kept out of the reach of small children to minimise the risk of suffocation.
- Protect the cardboard from direct sunlight to prevent material fatigue or discolouration.
- Ensure that the carton is stored in a dry environment to maintain strength and stability.
- Avoid overloading the box to prevent the risk of disintegration during transport.
