Safety Instructions:

- The cabinet should always be placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Observe the maximum load capacity of the drawers: 75 kg for 50 mm panel height, 200 kg for 150 mm panel height or higher.
- Only use the drawers up to the specified maximum load of 75 kg or 200 kg to avoid overloading.
- Only open one drawer at a time to prevent the cabinet from tipping over.
- Use a cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Place the product out of the reach of children to prevent misuse and injury.
- Keep the cabinet dry and clean to prevent corrosion; do not use in humid environments.
- Use anti-tip protection and individual drawer locks to prevent accidents.
- Use ergonomic aids when transporting heavy loads to avoid injuries.
- Ensure that the drawers are closed when not in use to avoid injury.
- Check the drawers regularly for damage and that the cylinder lock is functioning properly.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for installation and use to ensure safe use.
