Safety Instructions:

- Use individual drawer locks to avoid the risk of tipping and to ensure safety when opening several drawers at the same time.
- Do not load drawers beyond the maximum load capacity (75 kg or 200 kg) to ensure safety and stability.
- Place securely on level surfaces to prevent tipping; activate anti-tip protection when fully loaded.
- Use the cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access to the contents; keep the key in a safe place.
- Keep the cabinet away from children as it could tip over due to its height and weight.
- Protect product from impacts and mechanical stresses; robust surface protects against mechanical stresses.
- Take appropriate protective measures to avoid injury during assembly, transport or use.
- Check the linear guide for correct fit to prevent unintentional movements.
- Check for damage and functionality before use and check regularly for mechanical damage and corrosion.
- When cleaning, use suitable agents to avoid damaging the surface; protect from moisture.
- Keep the product out of the reach of children.
- Do not open drawers fully at the same time to prevent the cupboard from tipping over.
- Keep heavy objects in the bottom drawers to ensure stability.
- Keep away from liquids and chemical substances to avoid damage.
- Read and follow the user instructions before use to ensure safe handling of the cabinet.
- Only allow authorised persons access to the drawers.
- Carry out regular maintenance and inspections to avoid safety risks due to wear and tear.
- The cabinet is heavy (up to 270 kg); appropriate safety precautions must be taken during transport.
- Check the single drawer lock to ensure safety during operation.
