Safety Instructions:

- Secure all hinges and door mechanisms correctly to prevent injury and ensure that doors are fully open to prevent wedging.
- Ensure that the cabinet is stable, on a level surface and on a stable base in accordance with the instructions to ensure that it is stable and cannot tip over.
- Attach warning notices to draw attention to the possible risk of tipping over in the event of improper handling.
- Never overload: The maximum load capacity or load on the shelves must not be exceeded in order to maintain structural stability and safety.
- Avoid excessive weight on the doors or unsuitable safety precautions to prevent damage and jamming.
- Keep doors and hinges clean and in good working order to avoid malfunctions and crushing.
- The products are intended for indoor use; use in accordance with the intended use to avoid exposure to the weather.
- Use suitable hand tools and carefully follow the assembly instructions during assembly and installation to avoid accidents.
- Avoid contact with sharp edges and ensure that there are no loose parts that could cause injury.
- The product must be kept out of the reach of children, suitable child safety precautions must be observed and retractable doors must be opened at a safe distance from other persons.
- Use the safety devices provided to ensure safe use.
- When opening and closing the doors, make sure that no body parts are in the danger zone to avoid crushing injuries.
- Keep the cabinet away from moisture to prevent material damage.
- Ensure that all doors are correctly installed and close properly to prevent injury from improper use.
- Heavy objects should be positioned on the lower shelves to minimise the risk of tipping.
- The acoustic front offers no protection against intensive impacts; please note that the cabinet is not designed as protective furniture.
