Safety Instructions:

- Read the operating instructions carefully before using the product.
- Do not overfill the mobile tank system to prevent overflowing and a possible fire hazard (maximum filling quantity: 60 litres or 95 litres).
- The mobile tank system may only be used for transporting petrol.
- Handle the fuelling hose carefully when refuelling to avoid leaks.
- Do not use the system near open flames or other sources of ignition.
- The electric pump may only be used outdoors or in well-ventilated areas.
- Ensure that the mobile fuelling system is parked on a stable, level surface.
- Keep the mobile tank system out of the reach of children (not suitable for children - choking hazard due to small parts of the pump).
- When operating the electric pump, wear suitable protective equipment, e.g. gloves and safety goggles.
- Report any leaks immediately and take suitable measures to limit the damage (in the event of a petrol spill, carry out suitable cleaning measures immediately).
- Fire hazard due to petrol vapours.
- Risk of electric shock with electric models if not used properly.
- Only use the mobile refuelling system for its intended purpose.
- Do not store or use petrol in closed rooms.
- The mobile fuelling system may only be used by persons of legal age.
- Avoid contact with petrol on the skin.
- Only operate the electric pump when it is dry and do not bring it into contact with water.
- Do not use the product in bad weather or extreme heat.
- Carry out regular maintenance and inspection of the seals and flame arrester.
- Do not use inside buildings to avoid fire and explosion hazards.
- Keep the mobile fuelling system away from ignition sources and extreme temperatures.
- Protect from heat, sparks and naked flames.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment (e.g. gloves, safety goggles).
- Clean carefully after use to avoid leaks.
- Only allow trained personnel to handle the appliance.
- Only use the product in accordance with the applicable regulations for the transport of dangerous goods.
