Safety Instructions:

- Avoid risk of injury from sharp edges. Take care when handling sharp edges on the metal housing.
- The waste bin must be checked regularly for rust and damage to ensure safety and value retention. Damage to the powder coating should be treated to prevent corrosion.
- The waste container should only be used for the intended waste in order to avoid health risks and environmental pollution. Not suitable for flammable materials, keep the container away from open flames and extreme heat sources.
- Ensure that the waste bin is placed on firm, level ground and is not overloaded to avoid tipping, deformation or the risk of falling. Empty regularly to prevent overfilling and the risk of fire.
- The waste bin must be used in an upright position to prevent it from tipping over. Follow the user instructions for use and maintenance exactly.
- The key for the triangular lock should be kept out of the reach of children. Observe the safety instructions for using the triangular lock to prevent unauthorised opening.
- Do not leave children unattended near the waste bin and a supervisor should monitor its use to ensure that children are not endangered.
- The ashtray should be emptied regularly to avoid overfilling and the risk of fire. Avoid the risk of suffocation from small parts in the ashtray.
- In direct sunlight, the surface temperature of the container may increase; take this into account to avoid burns.
- Dispose of the waste container in accordance with local waste management regulations at the end of its service life.
