Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the wardrobe is standing on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Use a suitable lock, such as a rotary bolt or cylinder lock, to prevent unauthorised access. With cylinder locks, make sure not to mix up the key.
- Do not exceed the maximum load (wardrobe 80 kg) to avoid structural damage or accidents. Do not overload the shelves or compartments.
- Regular inspection of doors and locks for functionality and possible damage.
- Keep the wardrobe away from direct heat sources to prevent material damage.
- Keep ventilation slots at the top and bottom free to ensure air circulation.
- Only use recommended padlocks (shackle thickness 5-7 mm).
- Do not use in damp rooms to avoid rust formation.
- Keep small parts, e.g. screws, out of the reach of children to avoid the risk of suffocation.
- Do not equip cupboards with flammable materials or place them in the vicinity of such materials.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions during assembly to ensure stability.
- Do not clean products with abrasive or aggressive cleaning agents.
- Keep children away from cupboard doors to avoid injury.
- Pay attention to sharp edges, especially during assembly, to avoid injuries.
- Only use lockers for dry clothing and in work areas to avoid confusion with street clothing.
- Ensure that the materials are processed and disposed of in an environmentally friendly manner.
- Not suitable for children under 36 months due to choking hazard from small parts.
