Safety Instructions:

- Suitable for use in public areas. There is a risk of injury if used incorrectly.
- Make sure that the locker is safely secured against falling over to prevent accidents.
- Smaller parts could pose a choking risk for small children; supervision is required.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for safe use.
- Check the product for damage before commissioning to avoid safety risks.
- Use suitable locks (shackle thickness 5-7 mm) for padlocks to prevent theft.
- Caution: Sharp edges can pose a risk of injury. Take care when assembling and using the appliance.
- Doors are equipped with ventilation slots that should not be blocked to ensure proper air circulation.
- Only use indoors; the product is not weatherproof.
- Ensure that the clothes rails and shelves are not overloaded to prevent breakage and tipping over.
- Ensure that the locker is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Ensure that the product is kept dry to prevent rust.
- Fit the doors with a suitable lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Have the product certified in accordance with the applicable safety standards for metal furniture and use only environmentally friendly materials.
- Regular maintenance and inspection are necessary to ensure safety and functionality.
- The product is not suitable for children under 3 years due to small parts representing a choking hazard.
- Ensure that no sharp objects are introduced into the ventilation slots.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on wardrobe doors to prevent damage and injuries.
- Keep the product out of reach of children and unauthorized access.
- Ensure all assembly and usage steps are followed correctly to maintain stability and prevent accidents.
- Do not exceed shelf load limits to avoid tipping or breaking.
