Safety Instructions:

- Before standing up abruptly from the chair, ensure that the chair is stable to prevent falls.
- When using the unfolded chair, ensure that all four legs are in contact with the floor to prevent tipping.
- Avoid overloading the chair; keep to the maximum weight limit.
- Only use the chair for its intended purpose to avoid injury.
- When handling armrests, take care to avoid crushing and avoid excessive leaning.
- Stackable chairs must be stacked securely to prevent tipping or falling.
- Check the chair regularly for loose parts or damage to ensure safety.
- Use the chair on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Ensure that suitable safety precautions are taken with highchair products.
- Make sure that no fingers are trapped when stacking the chairs.
- Provide care instructions and instructions for safe use to ensure longevity.
- Ensure that there are no sharp edges or corners that could cause injury.
- Avoid improper use that puts excessive strain on or damages the chair.
- Keep the chair away from open flames and strong heat sources.
- The upholstery should be checked regularly for wear and tear to ensure seating comfort.
- The chair is designed for indoor use and should not be used outdoors.
- Ensure that the chair is correctly assembled during use to ensure stability.
- Do not exceed the recommended stacking height to avoid falling.
- Ensure that the floor is level and free of obstacles to prevent falls.
- Avoid use by children without supervision; not suitable for children under 3 years of age due to choking hazard.
- Protect against falling accidents: Do not place the chair on high surfaces or use it improperly.
- Ensure that the chair is not overloaded; observe the maximum load capacity.
- Ensure correct assembly, as incorrect assembly can impair stability.
- Carry out regular inspections to ensure safety and functionality.
- The chair should be placed securely when there is a high visitor frequency.
- Do not place any sharp objects on the chair surface to avoid damage.
