Safety Instructions:

- Use only for the storage of substances hazardous to water.
- The shelf tray is not suitable for storing flammable substances.
- Risk of injury due to improper use when lifting or moving with a forklift truck.
- Risk of slipping due to improper handling when used with forklift trucks.
- Regularly check the stability and tightness of the shelf tray.
- Carry out regular inspections for damage and wear.
- Observe protective measures in case of contact with aggressive chemicals: wear suitable protective gloves and safety goggles.
- Risk of suffocation due to improper contact with chemical substances.
- Product not suitable for children's hands, supervision required.
- The operating instructions and safety information must be observed.
- Include safety information and instructions for safe use.
- Permanently label the load capacity (1000 kg) and the collection volume (220 litres).
- The shelf tray must not be overloaded (maximum load 1000 kg).
- Do not exceed the filling volume (maximum 220 litre collection volume).
- The tray is approved for the storage of substances hazardous to water, please note the specific requirements.
- Caution: Hazardous chemicals may leak if used improperly.
- Protect from chemical substances that could affect the material integrity.
- Take care when handling heavy loads; use suitable lifting equipment (e.g. forklift truck).
- The shelf tray must be placed stably on the crossbars to prevent it from tipping over.
- Suitable for use with forklift trucks, taking into account the ground clearance of 100 mm.
- Ensure monitoring of storage and transport conditions.
