Safety Instructions:

- Ensure the stability of the cabinet before and during use to prevent it from tipping over.
- Take care not to overload the cabinet so as not to jeopardise the construction and safety.
- Read the installation instructions carefully before installation.
- Adjust the floor glides correctly to avoid the risk of slipping and place the cabinet on a stable, level surface.
- Only use the security mechanisms provided, such as security turnbolts and cylinder locks, to prevent unauthorised access.
- Only use padlocks if they comply with safety standards in order to avoid risks.
- Do not store any sharp objects in the compartments to avoid injuries.
- Use the seat in accordance with the recommended weight limits and ensure that the weight is evenly distributed to prevent falls.
- Regular maintenance and inspection of mechanical parts and doors to ensure safety and smooth functionality.
- Keep the cabinet away from moisture and extreme temperatures to prevent damage.
- Do not use aggressive chemicals when cleaning to avoid damaging the coating of the cabinet.
- Handle sharp edges carefully during installation to avoid injury.
- Ensure adequate ventilation inside the cabinet to prevent mould growth.
- Follow the instructions for safe use of the locking mechanisms and avoid damaging mechanical parts.
- Keep the cabinet clean to ensure smooth operation of the doors and locking mechanisms.
- The cabinet is not suitable for children, avoid access for children.
- Do not use the cabinet outdoors without suitable protective measures to prevent moisture and corrosion damage.
- Keep the ventilation openings clear to ensure good air circulation.
- Avoid applying extreme force to the doors to prevent injury or damage.
- Make sure that the cabinet cannot tip over during transport.
- Don't despair if you have mechanical problems; consult a specialist.
- Be aware of choking hazard due to small parts.
- Risk of crushing when closing the doors.
