Safety Instructions:

- Distribute heavy objects evenly in the drawers to prevent the cupboard from tipping over.
- Avoid use on uneven or unstable surfaces as this may affect stability.
- The cabinet is not suitable for children. Keep it out of the reach of children to avoid injuries or the risk of choking on small parts.
- Regularly check the functionality of the castors and locks to ensure safe mobility.
- Do not exceed a load capacity of 200 kg; overloading can lead to damage and injury.
- Do not exceed a load capacity of 75 kg; overloading can lead to damage and injury.
- Secure the drawers before moving the cabinet to prevent them from opening or falling out unintentionally.
- Use lockable castors to prevent unintentional rolling away.
- Ensure that the cabinet is placed on a stable and level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Only open drawers individually to prevent the cupboard from tipping over.
- Ensure that all parts are properly installed and that the maximum load capacity is not exceeded.
- Do not use the product near heat sources or in humid environments to prevent rusting and damage.
- Take care when loading and unloading drawers to avoid crushing or injury.
- There is a risk of injury from falling drawers or overturning cupboards if the appliance is used incorrectly or overloaded.
