Safety Instructions:

- Regularly check and record the material's susceptibility to corrosion.
- Please note: Only suitable for the storage of water-polluting substances of GHS 1-4.
- Only store flammable liquids of GHS 1-3 after appropriate earthing/potential equalisation.
- The shelf container may only be used by trained personnel.
- Ensure that drip pans are intact and regularly checked for leaks.
- Wear suitable protective equipment when handling hazardous substances.
- Regular visual inspection and inspection for rust, corrosion and damage to the material.
- Ensure that the storage and transport conditions do not jeopardise safety.
- In the event of leaks, escaping liquids can drip down to the lowest shelf level.
- Do not overload the product, adhere to the maximum load.
- Use suitable personal protective equipment when handling hazardous substances.
- Only have them installed and operated by qualified specialists.
- Delivery is disassembled, final assembly by a specialised company required.
- Only make accessible to authorised persons.
- Use shelf containers in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Provide safety data sheets and clear instructions in understandable language.
- Only use forklift trucks and pallet trucks in compliance with the safety guidelines.
- Carry out regular maintenance and inspections in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Secure against unauthorised access, e.g. always keep the sliding gate closed.
- In an emergency, provide suitable extinguishing agents and ensure natural ventilation.
