

# Product Safety Information

## Laptop trolley with charging function, 2-point locking system, parking brake, various models. Versions

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Please note the technical data of the products!

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### Safety Instructions:

- Choking hazard due to small parts: Keep away from children and there is a risk of choking if handled incorrectly.
- Risk of electric shock due to improper handling of electrical sockets and components: Only use on dry, stable surfaces and handle in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Ensure that the laptop trolley is stable and on a level surface to prevent it from tipping over; parking brakes should be activated when not in use.
- Avoid using the trolley in a damp environment to prevent electrical hazards such as short circuits or electric shocks.
- The product should only be used under adult supervision to prevent unauthorised access to sockets by children.
- Observe the maximum load limits to avoid overloading the sockets and structural damage to the trolley.
- Use the integrated cylinder lock correctly to prevent unauthorised access.
- Make sure that the doors of the trolley are properly closed when charging laptops to prevent damage.
- Regularly check the overvoltage protection and the electrical connections for functionality and damage.
- Only use suitable power supply units recommended by the manufacturer to avoid damage and overheating.
- Secure the trolley when not in use or when loaded by using the parking brakes.
- Provision of clear, easy-to-understand safety information and instructions for use to prevent operating errors.
- Children under the age of 3 should not use the laptop trolley or have it near them to avoid the risk of suffocation or electric shock.
- Before each use, check all moving parts and electrical systems for damage or wear to rule out safety risks.
- Make sure that no liquids get into the charging compartments or sockets to avoid short circuits.
