Safety Instructions:

- Only store hazardous substances in accordance with the relevant health and safety regulations.
- Use the container only for intended waste types to avoid chemical reactions or hazardous releases.
- Device not suitable for untrained personnel.
- Place the container on a stable, level surface to prevent it from tipping over.
- Regularly check the seals and closures for damage to prevent leakage.
- Wear protective clothing and gloves when filling with hazardous substances.
- Observe the maximum load of 800 litres to avoid overloading.
- Use only for intended substances and applications; check compatibility of substances before storage.
- Wear suitable protective equipment when using containers; avoid contact with hazardous substances.
- Close and secure the container properly to prevent leaks.
- Carry out regular checks for corrosion damage.
- Comply with regulations for the disposal of hazardous waste.
- Inspection and maintenance of the container in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Check the container for damage before use.
- Clean the container properly after use and dispose of it safely.
- Keep fire and ignition sources away, especially with flammable materials.
- Avoid overcrowding and adhere to maximum capacity limits.
- Use containers in accordance with the ADR/RID/IMDG Code for Dangerous Substances.
