Safety Instructions:

- Only use shelf containers for the storage of water-polluting substances of GHS classes 1-4. Ensure safety when storing these substances by complying with all regulations.
- Regular inspection and maintenance of the racking container, in particular for corrosion and leaks in the 480 litre drip tray, are necessary.
- Personal protective equipment must be worn when handling hazardous substances. Only trained personnel may operate the container.
- The storage of flammable liquids (GHS 1-3) requires special safety precautions such as earthing or potential equalisation, especially in outdoor areas.
- Ensure that the shelving container is stable to prevent it from tipping over and is protected from external influences.
- Shelf containers must be installed by an authorised specialist company. All legal regulations and guidelines must be observed.
- Natural ventilation is required for the safe use of hazardous substances indoors and outdoors.
- Labelling and clear instructions for the safe use and disposal of stored hazardous substances must be provided.
- The drip tray must be checked regularly for leaks in order to minimise the risk of environmental damage.
- Necessary training for personnel in the handling of hazardous substances must be carried out regularly.
- Specific handling instructions must be followed for the safe use of pallet trucks and forklift trucks.
