Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the racking container is suitable for the specific hazardous substances (GHS 1-4 for water-polluting substances and GHS 1-3 for flammable liquids).
- Observe the safety regulations when storing water-polluting substances GHS 1-4 and use earthing for flammable liquids GHS 1-3.
- Use personal protective equipment when handling hazardous substances.
- Carry out regular checks for damage or leaks on drip trays and shelf containers.
- Drip pans must be used to prevent leaks.
- Provide safety information in understandable language and inform employees accordingly.
- Only use the product for its intended purpose and in accordance with the instructions.
- Regular maintenance and inspection of the racking container to ensure safety and longevity.
- Keep the sliding gate locked to prevent accidents and unauthorised access.
- When handling with forklift trucks or pallet trucks, observe safety precautions and do not exceed load limits.
- Check whether the location of the shelving container complies with local regulations.
- Pay attention to sensitivity to corrosion and carry out regular checks and logging.
- Protect against the weather when storing outdoors.
- Check access to drip pans regularly.
- Be aware of the risk of suffocation due to improper handling of IBC containers.
- Shelf container suitable for GHS 1-4 water-polluting substances; earthing/potential equalisation required for GHS 1-3 flammable liquids.
- Not intended for the storage of unsuitable substances.
- Installation and final assembly may only be carried out by authorised specialist companies.
