Safety Instructions:

- Shelf containers may only be used for the storage of suitable substances.
- When storing hazardous substances, check for leaks and regularly check and empty the drip tray.
- Compliance with the regulations for substances hazardous to water (GHS 1-4) is required.
- When used outdoors, potential equalisation/earthing is necessary, especially for flammable liquids (GHS 1-3).
- Use personal protective equipment (PPE) when handling hazardous substances.
- Carry out regular inspections and maintenance of the racking container to prevent corrosion damage.
- Allow access to storage areas for authorised persons only.
- Install the shelving container securely and in a stable position, away from heat sources or naked flames.
- Not suitable for storing food, possible choking hazard due to small parts.
- Avoid contact of the storage materials with water, ensure sufficient ventilation to avoid explosive vapours.
- Final assembly must be carried out by an authorised specialist company.
- Older persons or persons with disabilities should work under supervision.
- The product must be used in accordance with local regulations.
- Only be operated by trained personnel, especially when using pallet trucks or forklift trucks.
- Always keep the double-wing gate locked when the container is not in use to prevent unauthorised access.
- Carefully read the enclosed safety data sheets (SDS) for stored hazardous substances.
- In the event of improper handling or damage, inform the responsible authorities immediately.
- Include safety information in a language that is easy to understand.
