Safety Instructions:

- Wear suitable protective equipment when handling hazardous substances.
- Shelf container is suitable for the storage of water-polluting substances GHS 1-4. Ensures storage in accordance with GHS specifications and material data sheets.
- Collecting tray with a volume of 1920 litres available to prevent liquid leaks; check regularly for leaks and damage.
- Regular inspection and documentation due to the material's sensitivity to corrosion.
- Shelf container is weatherproof outside, indoor storage is recommended to avoid material damage; protect from extreme weather conditions and direct sunlight.
- Only trained personnel should operate the shelf container.
- For outdoor use with flammable liquids: Earthing/potential equalisation required; earthing is recommended when storing flammable liquids of GHS 1-3.
- Delivery is disassembled; final assembly must be carried out by an authorised specialist company.
- Observe safety measures when using forklift trucks and pallet trucks; ensure suitable handling.
- The shelf container should be positioned on a stable and level surface; do not overfill to avoid overflows.
- Regular maintenance and inspection of the sliding gate; keep it locked to prevent unauthorised access.
- Follow the disposal instructions for hazardous substances and take immediate action in the event of leaks.
- Avoid fire hazard through suitable storage of flammable liquids; ensure earthing when used outdoors.
- Provide clear instructions and safety information in advance of use; ensure staff are trained in the safe handling of hazardous substances and emergency procedures.
