Safety Instructions:

- Carry out regular checks and logging due to the material's sensitivity to corrosion.
- Safe storage of hazardous substances according to GHS 1-4 required; follow safety instructions for handling.
- Only store flammable liquids of GHS 1-3 under certain conditions such as earthing/potential equalisation.
- Only use the product outdoors with earthing/potential equalisation; ventilate sufficiently to prevent vapour accumulation.
- Check access and unlocking mechanisms and the drip tray regularly to prevent leaks.
- Sump tray has a capacity of 2760 litres; observe this when storing hazardous substances.
- Do not exceed the maximum storage capacity of 36 IBC containers to avoid overflows.
- Only use specially authorised specialists for final assembly and when making changes to the equipment.
- Ensure that all employees are familiar with the safety regulations for handling hazardous substances.
- Keep out of the reach of children and allow access only to authorised persons, lock the sliding gate.
- When using forklift trucks and pallet trucks, ensure sufficient stability to minimise risks.
- Before use, ensure that the racking container is suitable for the stored substances, GHS 1-4 for substances hazardous to water.
- Provide clear instructions on safe handling and possible uses before use.
- Ensure that the instructions for safe use and storage in the operating instructions are followed.
- Take care when handling hazardous substances; wear suitable protective equipment to avoid health hazards.
- Ensure earthing/potential equalisation for outdoor use, especially for flammable liquids (GHS 1-3).
- Carry out regular inspections for rust, damage and corrosion to ensure safety.
