Safety Instructions:

- The shelf container is suitable for water-polluting substances of GHS categories 1-4. Safe handling required.
- Regular inspection for corrosion damage to the steel and logging necessary.
- Regularly check that the drip tray is functioning properly and is not leaking.
- Safe handling of hazardous substances must be ensured by using suitable personal protective equipment, such as gloves and safety goggles.
- For hazardous substances of GHS categories 1-4, observe safety precautions and keep safety data sheets to hand.
- Product must be installed and maintained by authorised and trained specialists.
- When storing flammable liquids of GHS category 1-3, earthing/potential equalisation is required.
- For outdoor use, ensure earthing and protection from the weather.
- Materials handling equipment such as forklift trucks or pallet trucks require safety precautions.
- Do not overload: Observe the maximum load capacity and specifications such as 16 chemical pallets or 32 Euro pallets.
- Product may only be used in well-ventilated areas.
- Ensure that the shelving container is fully assembled before it is used.
- There is a risk of suffocation, leakage or fire if handled incorrectly, so safety precautions must be strictly observed.
- Observe regulations for the storage of flammable liquids such as earthing.
- Keep sliding gates closed during use and check their functionality regularly.
- Caution for outdoor use: suitable earthing measures recommended.
- Use safety devices such as lockable sliding gates.
