Safety Instructions:

- Store highly flammable liquids safely to avoid the risk of fire and do not store in the immediate vicinity of naked flames or sources of ignition.
- Avoid contact with water, as substances hazardous to water are stored, and observe the legal regulations.
- Wear protective clothing (gloves, goggles) when handling hazardous substances and flammable liquids.
- Only use in well-ventilated areas to avoid vapours from flammable liquids.
- Only store hazardous liquids and water-polluting substances in authorised quantities in accordance with the regulations.
- Regularly check the leak tightness, integrity and corrosion of the drip tray to prevent leaks.
- The drip tray must not be overfilled and must be placed on a stable, level surface; regular logging of the condition is required.
- Forklift trucks or pallet trucks should only be used by trained personnel, ensure that the tray can be driven under correctly.
- Do not use in the vicinity of flammable materials to avoid the risk of fire.
- To avoid risks, use the product only for the intended liquids and not for food.
- Ensure that the tray is only used for its intended purpose.
- Avoid hazards due to improper handling of flammable liquids by taking suitable protective measures.
- Carry out regular visual inspections for rust and damage as well as for the condition of the grating.
- Use of personal protective equipment necessary when handling hazardous and flammable substances.
- In the event of leaks, notify the relevant authorities immediately.
- Water-polluting substances and flammable liquids may only be stored in authorised quantities.
