Safety Instructions:

- Observe safety precautions for the storage of hazardous substances.
- Regularly check and maintain access to technical exhaust air systems to ensure safety and prevent explosions.
- Do not overload the cupboard and observe the maximum load capacity of the shelves; maximum 75 kg per shelf.
- Lock hinged doors securely and check their locking mechanism regularly.
- Place the cabinet in a well-ventilated area away from sources of ignition.
- Provide suitable extinguishing agents in the event of a fire.
- Before use, be aware of any chemical hazards and wear personal protective equipment.
- Safety precaution: The cabinet must be properly ventilated before storing hazardous substances.
- Ensure that the lock mechanism is always closed when the cabinet is not in use to prevent unauthorised access.
- For indoor use only; the product is not suitable for outdoor use.
- Store toxic or aggressive chemicals in accordance with the relevant safety regulations and only in the compartments provided.
- Be aware of the risk of suffocation from chemicals, improper handling or storage of small parts and maintain ventilation.
- Only use the safety storage cabinet in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and the applicable local regulations.
- Check the floor drip tray regularly for leaks and replace if necessary.
- Do not load above the maximum permissible load weight and ensure that the ventilation system is not blocked.
- Lock the cabinet securely after each use to prevent unauthorised access.
- Only store flammable chemicals in the prescribed quantities.
- Check the contents of the safety storage cabinet regularly for signs of leakage or damage.
- Regular training on the handling and storage of hazardous substances is required.
- Ensure that all safety instructions are read carefully and that safety data sheets for the chemicals are observed.
