Safety Instructions:

- Read and follow the safety instructions before use.
- Observe the storage guidelines for chemicals: aggressive, flammable and toxic substances.
- Keep the hinged door closed when not in use to prevent access.
- Product under manufacturer's responsibility according to product safety guidelines.
- Wear suitable protective equipment when handling chemicals.
- Store toxic and aggressive chemicals in accordance with regulations.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Store the product in a dry, cool place and out of the reach of children.
- Regularly check the seals and function of the ventilation system.
- Avoid external ignition sources for flammable liquids.
- Cabinet fire-resistant (F30), ventilated operation.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of the pull-out trays (25 kg).
- Check safety valves and emergency shut-offs regularly.
- Storage of hazardous substances in accordance with national regulations.
- Only use for storing toxic, aggressive chemicals or flammable liquids.
- Ensure explosion protection through exhaust air system (10-fold air exchange).
- Only authorised personnel for operation and access.
- Always use a profile cylinder lock to prevent unauthorised access.
- Always have safety data sheets for chemicals to hand.
- Check the cabinet regularly for damage and function.
- Take appropriate measures to prevent fires.
- Store flammable liquids safely to avoid fire hazards.
- Place the cabinet on a stable surface and prevent it from tipping over.
- Use technical exhaust air systems to remove hazardous vapours.
- In the event of a fire, do not open the cupboard to prevent the fire from spreading.
- Protect the cabinet from sunlight and heat sources.
