Safety Instructions:

- Ensure that the angle plate is installed in accordance with the enclosed instructions to avoid the risk of accidents due to instability or tipping over.
- Use the angle plate only for its intended use and avoid improper applications to prevent injury or structural damage.
- Keep children away from the angle plate during use; it is not suitable for children without supervision.
- Regularly check the stability, safety mechanisms and screw connections of the mounted angle plate, especially after frequent height changes.
- Observe the maximum load and height (e.g. 898 mm) to avoid damage and safety risks.
- Only use the angle plate on the intended surface and at the intended height to minimise the risk of falling and injury.
- Ensure that there are no sharp edges or protruding parts that could cause injury.
- Avoid contact with water or liquids to protect the electrical parts of the angle plate.
- If you are unsure about installation or use, consult a specialist and use suitable tools and PPE for installation.
- Read the installation instructions carefully and follow all instructions for safe use.
- Avoid using the angle plate as a climbing aid to prevent injuries.
- Make sure there is sufficient clearance so that no kitchen or other objects are touched and no body parts can be trapped on electrically height-adjustable desks.
- Instructions for use and safety information must be available in understandable language and should contain clear instructions for installation and use.
